



Take the Light Rail Challenge!

Celebrate the ten-year anniversary of LINK Light Rail and discover several new walks. We've designed this walk series with routes that capture all the Light Rail Stations along the line.

Participants shall complete a minimum of 12 different qualified walks. Choose any length of route, when varying options are available. To qualify, the walk route shall start or finish at a Light Rail Station, or shall walk by the entry to a Light Rail Station, or shall walk alongside or cross Light Rail tracks, or any combination thereof. See next page for current list of qualified walks. More are planned for the course of the Challenge. Clubs are encouraged to create new walks for the Light Rail Challenge. Interested clubs can contact Emerald City Wanderers to add new events to the list.

Participants shall purchase the Light Rail Challenge book to record their completed events – see Order Form below. Participants shall register and pay event credit fee for each walk, and stamp their book for that event upon completion of the walk. Send completed books to Emerald City Wanderers for confirmation of achievement, and receive this embroidered patch, commemorating the Challenge.

Downtown / Waterfront – Y0011

New alternate start at International District Light Rail Station. Also, route walks by all the downtown Light Rail Stations.
